BEHIND THE WHEEL

Join us for Behind the Wheel, a road safety course designed to help young people become safer drivers. It will provide inexperienced drivers with a chance to develop a deeper appreciation of road safety, and the implications of driver behaviours.

CONTENT

The program includes:

- presentations from our First Responders
- interactive sessions including vehicle checks and maintenance
- learner driver skills
- distractions and possible consequences of.
- questionnaires
- people with lived experience
- videos on road safe practices.



- 1 in 6 learners had exceeded the speed limit by between 10 and 25 km/h on a recent trip and 1 in 4 had driven when fatigued – to behaviours commonly implicated in serious road crashes.
- About 1 in 5 teens who failed to wear a seat belt at all when driving – or a helmet if riding a motorcycle, had done so on all of their past 10 trips.
- Around 1 in 10 teens had also been the passenger of a driver who was under the influence of either alcohol or drugs.
